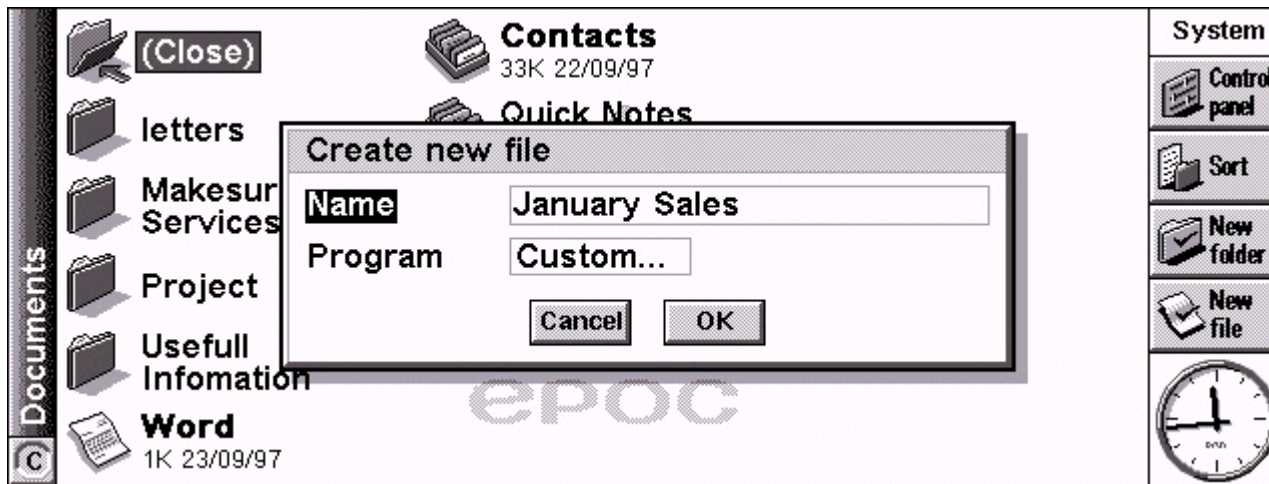
DCustom

What is DCustom?

DCustom is a small utility that extends the new file dialog in the system app.

How do you use DCustom?

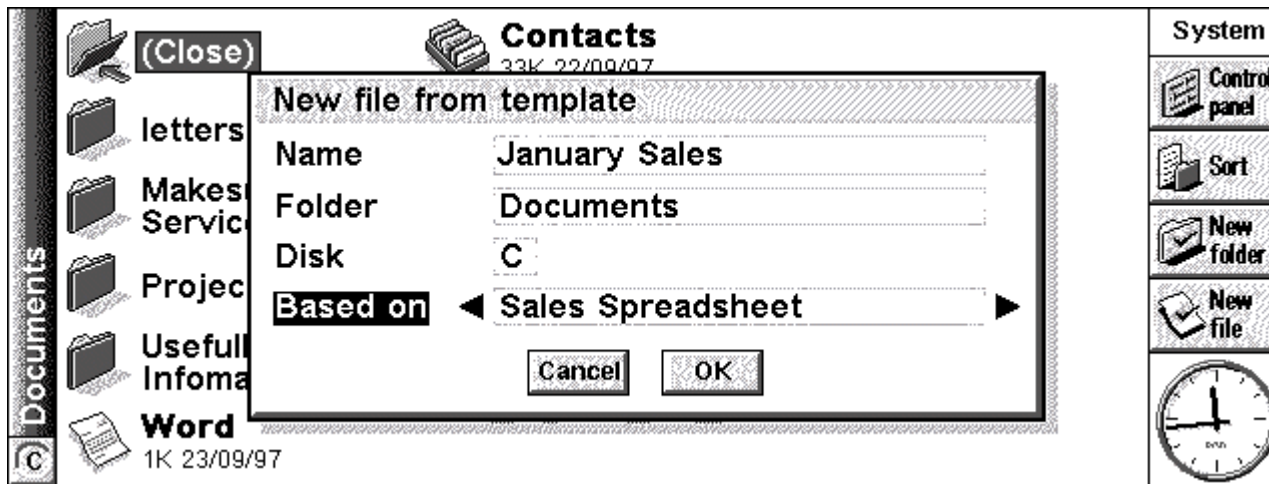
First click the new file button on the left of the system screen. This brings up the standard new file dialog. Enter the name of the file you want to create, select **custom...** as the program name and click ok.



A New dialog pops up which allows you to confirm the name and location of the file you wish to create.

The bottom choice list contains the names of files from the '**C:\TEMPLATE**' directory, when you click ok that file will be copied to the name you have specified, and the new file is opened.

By placing word, sheet, data files in the '**C:\TEMPLATE**' you can use any file as a template.



Is it available for public use?

DCustom is freeware. To install create a directory '**DCustom**' in '**/System/Apps**' and copy the files in the zip file below to it . Then create a **C:/TEMPLATE** directory and place in it the files you want to act as templates. The bugs listed below may be fixed in future versions, if there is enough interest.
